Congressman Juan Vargas gives keynote address at International Tribute Awards Gala

SAN DIEGO (October 16, 2015) In celebration of the dynamic, binational San Diego-Tijuana region, the San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce will host the International Tribute Awards Gala this evening. The event honors those outstanding individuals and businesses that have made a significant impact in the effort to bridge the U.S. and Mexican economies. Honoree Congressman Juan Vargas will give the evening's keynote address.

- Pacific Imperial Railroad and Baja California Railroad, "Cross Border Collaboration" award recipients for their joint efforts to reestablish the binational railroad.

Advances to our regional ports of entry will continue to bolster the strengths in our human and business capital and help our border realize its full economic potential," stated Rep. Juan Vargas (CA-51). "I want to thank the San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce for honoring me with the Cross Border Leadership Award and I would like to thank them for working to ensure that our region taps into our greatest resources. Their collaborative efforts truly demonstrate the positive impacts an organization can bring to improving our mega region."

San Diego Mayor Kevin Faulconer and Xavier Peniche, Secretary of Economic Development for the City of Tijuana, will also take part in the evening's program to provide an update on the cross-border agenda of their respective cities.
